

Stellar Volume Repair 3.0 User Guide

Overview

Mac OS stores information about the number, names, locations, types, and sizes of files and folders saved on the disk in a directory. The information stored in directory gets constantly updated, as applications create, delete or modify files. If for some reason, this information is not updated accurately or not updated at all, the directory is considered damaged. A damaged directory results in a number of volume errors and crashes. Also, some of your data may get lost due to errors in volumes.

Stellar Volume Repair has been designed to rebuild damaged Mac OS directory. It scans entire volume and checks catalog file, journaled files, extents overflow file, attribute files, multi linked files, volume bit map, and volume information. Then the tool creates a new directory with data it collects. Old directory is replaced with the newly created one, making your Mac Volume working once again.

Why Stellar Volume Repair?

Stellar Volume Repair incorporates numerous features in it. It performs a through scan of the selected Volume for errors and then successfully fixes most of the errors and rebuilds the Volume directory.

Repairs and Rebuilds Volume Directory

Stellar Volume Repair is capable of rebuilding the directory in most cases of volume errors. The corrupt directory is replaced with the repaired volume directory. All the data that was inaccessible due to errors can be accessed once again.

Supports Volume Journaling feature for non-boot Mac volumes

Journaling helps in protecting the integrity of Mac OS Extended file system on Mac OS X volumes. It also prevents your Mac disks from getting into an inconsistent state and speeds up the process of disk repair in case of volume failures.

Supports Volume Repair for External Storage

Removable storage media is supported by **Stellar Volume Repair**. If you have data on some external device and the Volume directory has developed errors, **Stellar Volume Repair** can repair it successfully. You have to attach the device and rebuild it using the tool.

Verify and Repair Disk Permissions

Verify all the disk permissions and repair the incorrect disk permissions. You can repair the boot volume disk permissions in case they have some errors.

Installation Procedure

Before installing the software, ensure that your computer meets minimum system requirements.

Minimum System Requirements

- Processor: Intel Core i3 or better
- **Operating System**: Mac OS X 10.12, 10.11, 10.10, 10.9, 10.8, 10.7 and 10.6.
- Memory (RAM): Minimum: 1 GB Recommended: 2 GB
- Hard Disk: 50 MB of free space

Steps to install Stellar Volume Repair

To install Stellar Volume Repair, follow these steps:

- 1. Unpack StellarVolumeRepair.dmg.zip file.
- 2. Decompressing the zip file and double click the dmg file. This step will mount a virtual volume **Stellar Volume Repair**.
- 3. Double-click StellarVolumeRepair volume to open Stellar Volume Repair application window.
- 4. Drag Stellar Volume Repair file to the Applications folder.
- 5. To launch the software, double click on **Stellar Volume Repair** file in **Applications** folder.
- 6. This displays **License Agreement**. If user accepts the **License Agreement**, then the software is launched; otherwise, it terminates.

Note: To remove the software, drag and drop **Stellar Volume Repair** file from **Applications** folder to trash.

Registering the Tool

The demo version is just for evaluation purpose and must be eventually registered to use the full functionality of the software. The software can be registered using the Registration Key that you receive via email after purchasing the software.

To register the software:

- 1. Run the demo version of Stellar Volume Repair software.
- 2. On the main user interface, click the **Register** option. Register window is displayed as shown below:

- 3. If you don't have the registration key, click **Get it now** button in the window to go online and purchase the product.
- 4. Once the order is confirmed, a Registration Key will be sent to the email provided.
- 5. Type the **Registration Key** (received through email after purchasing the product) and click **Register** button (Please ensure that you have an active Internet connection).
- 6. The software would automatically communicate with the license server to verify the entered key. If the key you entered is valid, software will be registered successfully.
- 7. '*Product registered successfully* ' message is displayed after the process is completed successfully. Click **OK**.

Update

Update feature available in **Stellar Volume Repair** allows you to check and install the latest updates for the application. This will help you keep your application up-to-date. If updates are available for the product, update wizard pops up while you run **Stellar Volume Repair**. Otherwise, you can choose **Check for Updates** option, by clicking on **Preferences** icon on **Stellar Volume Repair** main screen.

To update Stellar Volume Repair, do one of the following:

- 3. If updates are available, **Update** window is displayed. Follow the next step. Else, if no updates are available, a message that **No updates are available** is displayed.
- 4. Click **Update** button to download the latest version. It may take few seconds to minutes to download the files. After completion, Update successfully installed message appears. Click **OK**.

To set a frequency for updates:

- 1. In *Preferences* window, choose **Check for updates** option and specify frequency to check for updates **daily**, **weekly** or **monthly**.
- 2. Click **OK**.

Repair Directory

To repair a directory,

- 1. Launch Stellar Volume Repair.
- 2. From the main screen, click **Select Volume to Repair** option.



3. Select the desired volume to repair and click **Repair** button.



4. A screen which displays the phases and status of the directory repairing process is displayed. If you wish to stop the process at any point, click **Stop** button.

5. Following three cases may arise as a result of repair process:

- The volume is correct and there is no need to repair the directory.
- Stellar Volume Repair repairs the directory.
- The directory is severely damaged but Stellar Volume Repair tries to repair it as much as it can
 and after completing the repairing process you will get a 'The volume repair was unsuccessful
 due to severe corruption of the volume. Please reconnect the drive and move your data to
 another volume' message. Click OK.

Note: Software doesn't support repairing of exFAT file system.

- 6. After verifying the structure, identifying the errors and repairing the new structure, you need to select the **Replace** button to start making changes to existing directory structure data.
- A 'Volume repaired successfully' message is displayed on the successful completion of the Repair

process.

Note: Don't stop the repairing process in the middle. It may corrupt the hard disk.

Note: Repair Button is always disable for the following cases:

- If your drive has a hardware problem like bad block cluster or bad sectors etc. which cannot be repaired.
- If your system has an encrypted drive partition or a system drive partition that cannot be repaired.

Disk Permissions

To verify and / or repair disk permissions,

- 1. Launch Stellar Volume Repair.
- 2. From the main screen, click on **Disk Permissions** option.

3. On the next screen, select the boot volume only to either verify or repair the volume.



Note: Verify and Repair buttons are functional for boot volume only.

4. Click on **Verify** button to list all the disk errors of the volume (if any) or you can click **Repair** button to directly start repairing a volume without verifying it first.

Note: In case if you want to abort the verification or repair process, simply click the Stop button.

5. A 'Process Completed' message is displayed once the verification or repair process is complete.

Note: Don't stop the verification process in the middle. It may corrupt the hard disk.

Volume Journaling

To enable or disable volume journaling,

- 1. Launch Stellar Volume Repair.
- 2. From the main screen, click on **Volume Journaling** option.



3. On the next screen, select the volume which you want to journal.



4. Click on **Enable** button to start protecting the integrity of the volume's file system.

Or,

5. Click on **Disable** button to stop journaling the volume's file system.

Create Bootable USB

Stellar Volume Repair gives you option to create bootable USB. You can use the bootable USB to boot your computer, if the operating system fails. Bootable USB is also useful if no operating system is loaded, or the hard drive is blank.

To create a bootable USB,

- 1. Run Stellar Volume Repair application.
- 2. From the main screen, click Select Volume to Repair option.
- 3. A window with a list of volumes appears.



4. Select boot volume and click Next.

Note:

- Create Bootable USB option is available for boot volume only.
- Do not stop the image creation process in the middle. It may corrupt your hard disk.

How to Boot from USB Drive?

Steps to boot your computer using USB drive:

- 1. Attach the USB Drive to the USB port of your computer.
- 2. Restart your computer and press <Option> key on your keyboard.
- 3. You will now see a list of attached drives/volumes in your computer.
- 4. Select the StellarBootableUSB bootable volume from the list.
- 5. Once you are done with this, your computer will start booting from your preferred device.
- 6. And finally, after the initialisation gets completed, you will see the Stellar Volume Repair running

on your screen.

You can also follow these steps to boot your volume:

- Click on System Preferences -> Startup Disk.
- Select the StellarBootableUSB bootable volume from the list of volumes.
- Click Restart.

Rebuild Boot OS Directory

To repair directory of boot OS:

- 1. Boot your Mac using the bootable USB, created through Stellar Volume Repair software.
- 2. **Stellar Volume Repair** is launched. Click on **Select Volume to Repair** option. A list of volumes is displayed by the application.
- 3. Select the desired volume to repair and click **Repair** button on the toolbar. The software starts repairing the directory after identifying the drive for errors.
- 4. Following three cases may arise as a result of repair process:
 - The volume is correct and there is no need to repair the directory.
 - Stellar Volume Repair repairs directory.
 - The directory is severely damaged but Stellar Volume Repair tries to repair it as much as it can
 and after completing the repairing process you will get a 'Volume is severely corrupted. It is
 advisable to disconnect the external device and reconnect to it and then move all your data
 another volume.' message. Click OK.
- 5. After verifying the structure, identifying the errors and repairing the new structure, you need to select the **Replace** button to start making changes to the existing directory structure data.

A '**Repair process successful**' message is displayed on the successful completion of the **Repair** process.

Note: Do not stop the repairing process in the middle. It may corrupt the hard disk.

FAQs

1. What does the demo version of Stellar Volume Repair do?

With demo version of the software, you can see if Mac directory needs to be repaired. To repair the directory, you need to purchase and register the software.

2. How to know that my Mac directory has been damaged?

There are a number of signs to indicate that your directory has been damaged. If you have problem opening or saving files, you are see a lot of error messages like - 'Invalid key length', 'Invalid index key', 'Invalid leaf record count',etc., or your Mac fails to boot, then your Mac's directory has been damaged and you will have to take remedial measures to get it back in working condition.

3. What are the causes of directory damage?

Mac OS stores information about the number, names, locations, types, and sizes of files and folders saved on the disk in 'Directory'. As applications create, delete or modify files, the directory gets updated. For Mac OS to work properly, it is absolutely necessary that information in the directory is updated accurately. The Mac OS temporarily caches directory information in memory for faster access. If this information does not gets written to disk, directory damage occurs. Other causes of directory damages are - improper shutdown, unexpected power loss, applications writing its own data to directory, etc.

4. Can using Stellar Volume Repair on a regular basis prevent severe directory damage from occurring?

Yes, many times directory damage may be minor and go unnoticed. Using **Stellar Volume Repair** on a regular basis fixes minor damage before it turns into a major one.

5. How can I repair directory if my boot drive is corrupted?

In a situation like this, create a bootable USB using **Stellar Volume Repair** on a system having the same hardware configuration as yours. Then use this bootable USB to boot your system and repair directory.
